

Senate Mandate

The Governance and Nominating Committee shall:

- 1. Advise Senate on operations, efficient and effective structures supporting good governance and appropriate linkages between Senate, Faculty Boards and other parts of the internal governance structure which operate with delegated authority regarding matters of academic policy.
- 2. Review and monitor the membership needs of the Senate and its standing and ad hoc committees and to solicit, receive and review names of potential members and recommend members for appointment to such committees by Senate.
- Advise Senate on the appointment of Senate representatives to bodies external to Senate and their committees.
- Advise Senate on the establishment, terms of reference, composition, membership and retirement of its standing and ad hoc committees and their respective sub-committees.
- Monitor and report to Senate on the effective operation of the Senate's standing and ad hoc committees and their sub-committees.

The Committee shall nominate, for the Faculty Senate's elections, members of all Senate Policy Councils and Committees and Joint Committees. Upon the President's request, the Committee shall make recommendations for presidential appointments. For nominations, the Committee shall consider diverse representation from the entire University from all appropriate ranks and with special qualifications where required. A major goal is to foster a faculty fully committed to the service component of its teaching, research and service mission.

The Executive Committee, regarding nominating members of the Nominations Committee, and the Nominations Committee, regarding nominating members of the other standing committees, will follow the "Selection Method" as described in § 131 (c) of Kerr and King, by receiving suggestions, seeking out candidates, and making recommendations. The Nominations Committee may present this list to the Executive Committee before circulation to the general membership, but is not required to do so. 2. The names put forward by the Executive Committee and the Nominations Committee, as the case maybe, are circulated in advance of the meeting at which the elections are to take place and otherwise as required when vacancies occur. It is the responsibility of the

Nominations Committee to present a slate of candidates for all committee positions except the Nominations Committee itself. It is the responsibility of the Executive Committee to present a slate of candidates for Nominations Committee. These committees will present their respective slates to Senate with sufficient names to fill the available positions. 3.

The chair will provide an opportunity for members to put forward further nominations by calling three times for nominations from the floor, thereafter nominations will close. 4.

If additional nominations are received at the meeting, the chair is responsible to confirm that each person concerned is eligible and willing to serve. This is done by the nominated individual standing and declaring at the meeting that they are willing to serve or by the Chair receiving a written statement signed by the nominated individual stating that they are willing to serve; and the secretary of the meeting confirming that the individual is eligible to serve given the membership requirements of such committee and the number of years the individual has already served as a committee member.

If the number of nominations is the same as the number of available positions on a committee, and no further nominations are received after the chair has called three times for nominations, the slate will be elected.

The Committee shall have as a standing order of business the making of nominations for such ad hoc selection committees as are charged to nominate to the Senate those to be appointed to senior academic administrative offices and to the offices of Vice-President (Administration) and Vice-President (University Advancement). In this context, senior academic administrative offices include those of Provost, Vice-President (Health Sciences), Vice-President (Research), Vice-Provost and Dean of Graduate Studies, Director of Continuing Education, academic Associate/Assistant Vice-Presidents, Associate Deans of Graduate Studies and/or Research, Associate Deans of Faculties (see Section 2(h)), Chair of Undergraduate Council, University Secretary, Registrar, University Librarian and such other positions as are designated by Senate from time to time. The Committee shall ensure that the nominations for each ad hoc selection committee include, as nominated Chair of the ad hoc selection committee, the name of the academic administrative officer to whom the appointee shall report. The Committee shall review, and express its opinion to the Senate on, nominations made by the ad hoc selection committees, before any commitment is made to the nominated candidate.

Key Messages:	 The term of office for faculty members, students, and professional support staff is three years, one year, and three years, respectively. They begin on September 1st and end on August 31st. When vacancies occur in the middle of a term, the new Senate appointments will be effective immediately and will end on August 31st of the remaining term of office. The Senate Nominating Committee recommends Senate approve nominees for appointment to Senate standing committees. While faculty, student and professional support staff senators have a three-year, one-year, and three-year term of office on Senate standing committees, their term of office on these committees will be the lesser of these terms and their elected term on Senate.


